The Davidian Seventh-day Adventist Association School of The Prophets <u>STUDENTS CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION</u>

All potential students should carefully consider the following before applying to the School. You should:

- Have acquired the age of 18 and not older than 34 years
- Be none meat eaters or willing to give up the meat diet
- Be single and unattached (That there is no immediate promise of marriage to be fulfilled)
- Have no family commitment/dependents for which they are financially responsible, unless these can be borne by another family member if accepted to the school.
- Have no financial constraint or outstanding Debts. (These can become burdensome as a student) and if so the information should be forthcoming to the interviewer.
- Should be able to speak, read and write English (The level will be evaluated at the interview), but should not be made a hindrance to your zeal and calling when applying to the School.
- Must be actively studying the Message, a member of one of the Davidian groups in your country, have been baptized in the Seventh-day Adventist denomination, and can be recommended by another Davidian, or Bashan Field Worker
- And be willing to divulge any known medical or other physical ailments which may hinder your active involvement in the daily activities at the school which is compulsory for all students

Please take note of the following:

- 1. A letter of recommendation must be sent in with the application, from your local group leader or a Bashan Field Worker
- 2. Two current passport size pictures
- 3. Proof of age (Birth Certificate) and national identity card (Photo ID)
- 4. On acceptance of the application all candidates must undergo a medical screening. (This will include a blood test).
